WHAT TO EXPECT

IMPLIED CONSENT CHARGES AND LICENSE RESTORATION

What to expect and how Jon Frank, as your lawyer, can help.

You are arrested for Drunk Driving, you may or may not have taken a PBT - Preliminary Breath Test

Officer requests a DataMaster Test at the Police Station - either breath or blood test

Jon's Tip: The name "Breathalizer" is misleading and vague. The proper terms are "Field Sobriety Test", and "Preliminary Breath Test (PBT)" on the road, and the "DataMaster Test" at the station.

You say YES and take their test - no issue

You say NO - and refuse the test

14 days from Date of Arrest to request a hearing with the Secretary of State. Up to this hearing, your license is pending

If no hearing is requested, your license is automatically revoked for one year. Requesting a hearing gives you a shot at keeping the license; delays revocation in any event.

You have been charged 2 or more times with OWI - your license has been revoked

- Substance Abuse Evaluation -SOS 258

Hearing date is set

Jon will help you with the hearing - including conducting the Microsoft Teams meeting in his Law Office.
